WHAT I DON'T SPEAK FROM THE AMBO:

Didn't our hearts burn as he spoke to us on the road and explained the Scriptures to us?

Today we celebrate the Third Sunday of Easter... a very special Easter... since we are all spending this time outside the temple, without being able to physically participate together in the Eucharist... today's reading becomes more palpable in our reality.

Have you ever thought about what the disciples of Emmaus felt when they were walking in solitude and met this wayfarer? I imagine that they were feeling sorrow, abandoned, desolate, sad... they had lost their way... their Teacher.

Imagine how they told this story to this walker... you know what?... it's the same for us. In these days we have not been able to participate in the Eucharist, we have not been able to share as a community of faith in the temple... I imagine that we are feeling at this moment what these two walkers felt back then.

To know that you believe in God, that you believe in the resurrection of Christ... and that the panorama is so bleak... is a great burden for our soul. But notice that the joy returns to them when they recognize that the one who was accompanying them was Christ. What a joy to know that they were not alone!

But on the other hand, the sadness of not having recognized Him immediately made them sad. Do you feel that this is our story? I have spoken with many people who have told me how sad they feel without being able to receive communion, others who have told me how they miss Mass... "father we didn't know what we had until we lost it" many people have made this comment to me.

But rejoice because this will come to an end, trusting in God, we will return. I ask God that many will learn and understand the lack of God in our lives ... and how much we suffer when we do not have Him present in our lives.
